Biomass in the Turning Point for Energy

The exploding prices of fossil fuels are presenting all of humanity with a pivotal problem: Where will the energy of tomorrow come from if the energy of today is already no longer affordable? Energy from biomass (and therefore a turning point for energy from fossil energy to renewable energy) is a central issue of the lecturers and excursions of the 14th Austrian Biomass Conference in Grieskirchen, Upper Austria. From 25 until 26 November 2008 Grieskirchen will be the focal point of national and international experts on the subject: "Biomass in the Turning Point for Energy".

Biomass is booming which has been shown by the growth rates of the biomass heating systems in Austria and Europe as well as the innovative products of domestic manufacturers, which in many areas are taking the technological lead in terms of market leadership in Europe for renewable energies. Biomass for energy production, however, is not only called for from the point of view of energy policy or ecological points of view. Economic reason also makes its use obvious. Continuously increasing prices for oil and gas are improving the calculation in favour of using biomass. Countering increasing energy prices requires joint action by consumers as well

as decision-makers and common efforts for promoting renewable energies as guarantors for stable energy prices and reducing dependency on fossil fuels.


In addition to the consequences for Austria of the EU-directive for renewable energies, the 14th Austrian Biomass Conference will be a "Tour d'Horizon" through current issues of biomass in the fields of energy policy, technology and science. 


